This is some of the last old growth hill timber that we know of. The red oak averages over six hundred board feet per tree and about 4,000 feet of the white oak volume is in large veneer quality logs. A lot of the large cottonwood was found in the 15 acres of the Swanee River bottom.



CONDITIONS OF SALE

- 1. Purchaser will pay for the timber at the time the contract is signed.
- The purchaser will have 24 months from the date of the contract to cut and remove the timber.
- 3. Only trees marked with blue paint by & Associates' foresters will be cut.
- The remaining stand will be protected by the purchaser to the greatest reasonable extent possible during logging.
- The purchaser will remove tops from fields, roads, streams, and the land of adjacent owners immediately upon felling.
- 6. Purchaser will repair immediately any fence damaged during the logging operation.
- State of Tennessee water quality best management practices (BMPs) will be followed during logging. Water bars will be constructed on all roads and major skid trails placed on steep (3% or greater) slopes.
- Purchaser will notify & Associates, Inc. when logging begins.
- Purchaser will discuss logging restrictions with logging foreman prior to beginning the logging operation.
- Purchaser will leave haul roads and loading areas in a smooth and passable condition when logging is completed. Log ends and other debris will be moved off loading areas into the woods.
- 11. The seller grants the right of ingress and egress upon the tract for the purpose of logging, however, logging will not be allowed if ground is wet enough to allow rutting in the woods and fields. An access road around the margin of each field will be allowed.
- 12. The seller guarantees title to the timber sold.
- 13. The seller shall not be responsible for damages to property or injuries to persons which may arise from, or be incident to, the use and occupation of the sale area or sale operation. Nor will the seller be responsible for damages to the property of the purchaser or for damages to the property or injuries to the persons of the seller's officers, agents, or employees, or others who may be on the sale area at the invitation of the purchaser or any of his officers, agents, or employees.
